In January, **Bell Let's Talk** urges Canadians to turn and face and talk about mental health – sharing how we are all impacted and we are all a part of the wave that can move mental health out of the shadows and into the light. The annual Bell Let's Talk initiative was launched 2010, with the important goals of fighting the stigma, improving access to care, supporting research, and embedding mental health tools in the workplace. Every year since its inception, the swell of commitment to this initiative grows, conversations become bolder, and momentum of support carries the vision to new heights of change and action.

At AgeCare, mental health is a vital component of our philosophy of person-centred care. Over the past several years, we have played a role in improving access to care by integrating a mental health care component in our residential facility at AgeCare SkyPointe. This fall, in partnership with AHS, we took our commitment one step further, opening a state-of-the-art mental health residence to provide specialized care for those 18 years and older with complex mental health needs.

The purpose-built SkyPointe Mental Health Community houses our earlier established 64-bed mental health long-term care program, along with an added 32-bed specialized mental health program operated by AHS.

Designed to meet the unique needs of its residents, the SkyPointe Mental Health Community offers an inclusive, respectful, comfortable and dignified space where individual can receive the mental health and well-being services they deserve, allowing them to focus on their recovery.

We look forward to continuing to provide these essential services, and will unveil the residence publicly in the coming months.

Help Prevent the Spread



At AgeCare we understand that it is our responsibility to do all we can to protect ourselves, and the vulnerable people who count on us daily to keep them as safe and well as possible. Vaccines for respiratory illnesses are one of the simplest and most effective ways we can do this.

Thank you to those who recognize the importance of getting vaccinated and have gone out of your way to ensure you have received all the vaccines you are eligible for. Together we will do our part in taking care of ourselves and our communities.

Other ways to help **prevent the spread of respiratory illnesses**, including COVID-19 and Influenza are:

- Cover your mouth and nose with a tissue or your sleeve when you cough or sneeze.
- Wash hands often with soap and water thoroughly for at least 20 seconds.
- Avoid touching your face, nose, or mouth with unwashed hands.
- Stay home if you are feeling unwell.
- Avoid close contact with people who are sick.

Individuals 5 years and older can get their Influenza vaccine at the same time as the COVID-19 vaccine at participating pharmacies, some community medical clinics and select Alberta Health Services sites. For more details call 811, or visit a walk-in clinic.

**Additionally, all seniors older than 65 can get a free enhanced Influenza vaccine this year. Enhanced influenza vaccines (FLUZONE® High-Dose Quadrivalent) give seniors better protection against influenza than standard-dose vaccines. Enhanced influenza vaccines stimulate stronger immune responses, compensating for the natural weakening of the immune system that occurs with age.
